	Usage	Publication
European Commission	Use primarily OSS in developing Software. foster participation of developers to OSS communities by submitting patches, contributions, ... The European Commission formalized its Open Source strategy since 2000	
Spain	Since 2007, Public administrations should use FOSS	Egov Law gives public administrations the right to share software they develop on GitHub
France	Circulaire Ayrault (2012) requires administrations to make a "systematic review of free alternatives"	Several publications on Adullact, a specific collaboration platform for French administrations
UK	GDS (Government Digital Service) Technology Code of Practice requires that "you ... considered using open source and publishing your code openly."	Several programs like the NHS open source program promote publication of software
Italy	Each gov agency can decide if they want to use the "Codice Amministrazione Digitale" that makes the usage of FOSS mandatory . That's a question of ethics.	
Malta	Open Source policy (2012) seeks to maximize re-use of procured software by enabling the distribution of Gov solutions as OSS.	

Une large communauté de développeurs Open Source en Europe

- ~50% des développeurs des projets Eclipse sont Européens
- Les autres fondations ont aussi une voix forte en Europe
- Le marché OSS représente >4B€ en France, UK et Allemagne
 - cf [2017 PAC Study](#)
- L'OSS embauche 8200 personnes en France en 2019
 - cf [2018 PAC study](#)
 - Marché de 4.4B€ en 2017
 - OSS représente plus de 10% du marché IT français
 - 8% de croissance par an
- OSS a été une approche tactique des entreprises. En 2019, 71% des entreprises considèrent l'open source comme stratégique

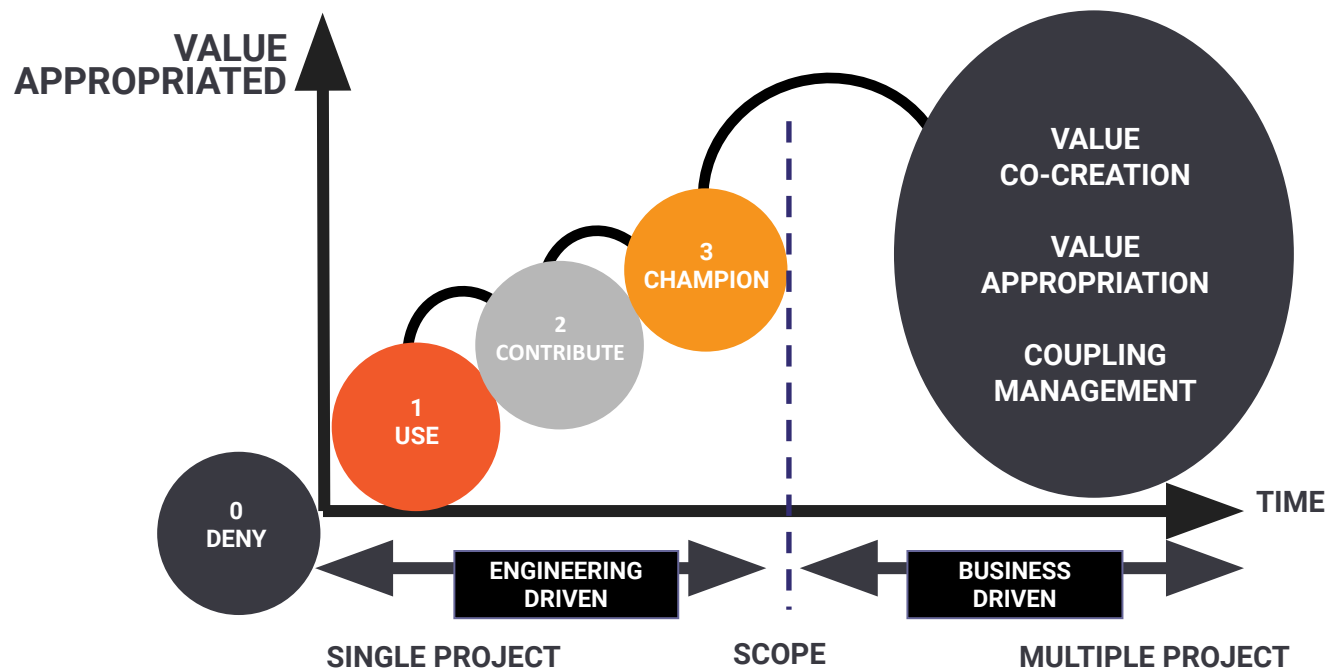

Open Source Maturity Model

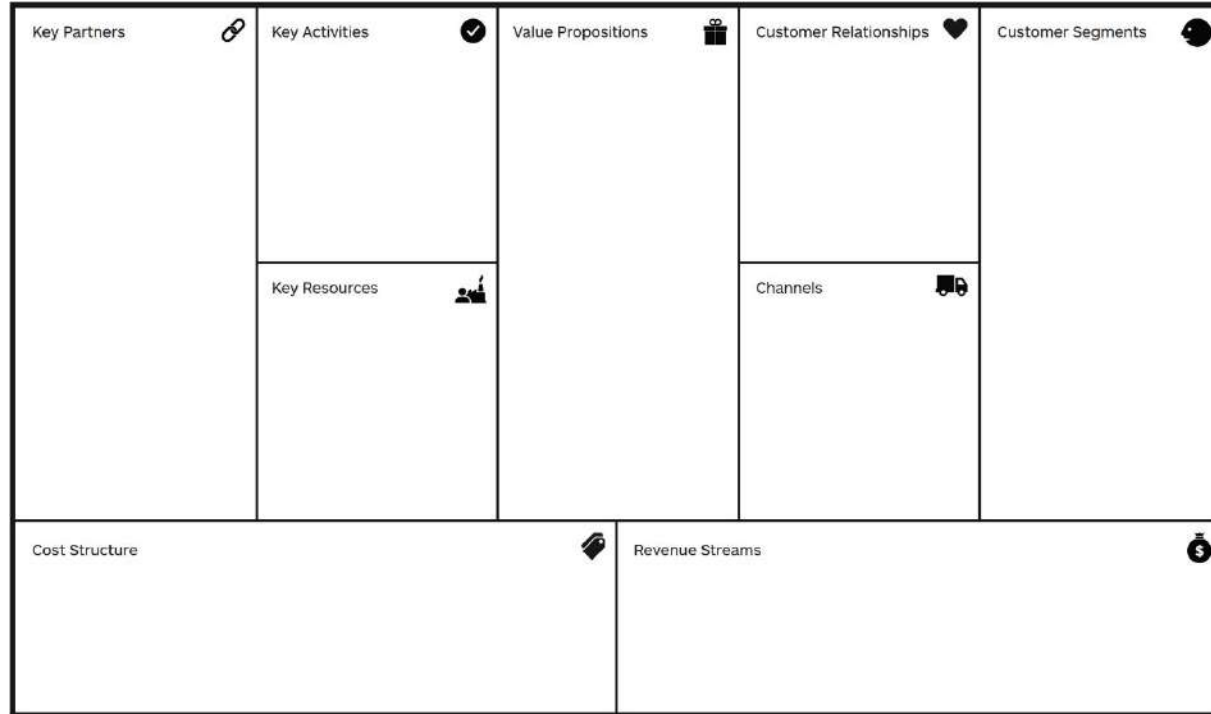




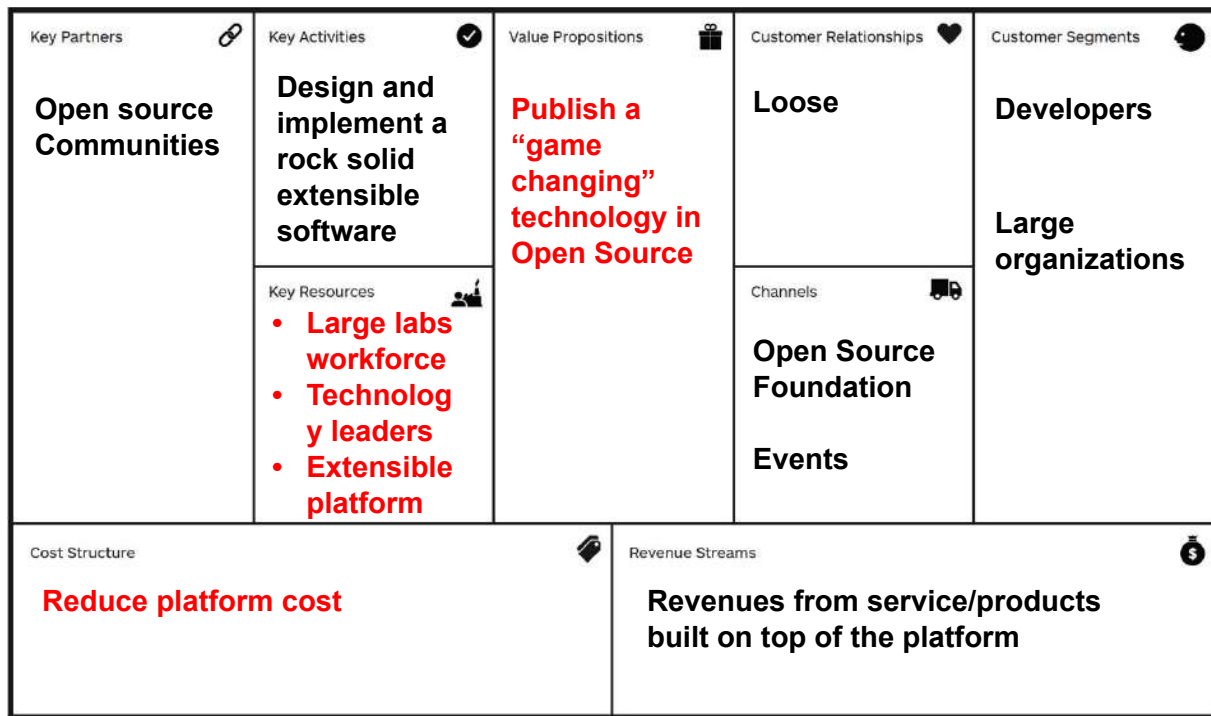
